WHEREAS, pursuant to Act 188, Public Acts of Michigan of 1954, as amended ("Act 188"), the Township Board may proceed to initiate and carry out the collection and disposal of garbage and rubbish; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board has received a proposed plan of Collection and Disposal of Garbage and Rubbish, the proposed locations thereof and an estimate of the costs of the same, with total estimated costs of \$34,428 annually, all as described on the attached Exhibit A: and

WHEREAS, the Township Board tentatively determines that there is a need for the proposed Collection and Disposal of Garbage and Rubbish described in Exhibit A to serve the properties within the proposed district described in the attached Exhibit B; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board desires to proceed with the proposed Collection and Disposal of Garbage and Rubbish to benefit the properties within the proposed district described in the attached Exhibit B.

The Township Board tentatively declares its intent to make the proposed Collection and Disposal of Garbage and Rubbish described in the attached Exhibit A, together with the necessary work incidental thereto, within the proposed district described in the attached Exhibit B.

2. The Township Board tentatively designates the special assessment district against which the costs of the proposed Collection and Disposal of Garbage and Rubbish are to be assessed as proposed Summerfield Township Collection and Disposal of Garbage and Rubbish Special Assessment District, which shall include the lands and premises more particularly described in the attached Exhibit B.

3. The plans and estimate of costs for Collection and Disposal of Garbage and Rubbish are currently on file with the Township Clerk and shall remain available for public examination during ordinary business hours and at the public hearing.

4. The Township Board shall conduct a public hearing to hear any objections to the proposed Collection and Disposal of Garbage and Rubbish, to the estimate of costs, and to the special assessment district proposed to be established for the assessment of the costs of such Collection and Disposal of Garbage and Rubbish, on August 17, 2021, at 7p.m., at the Summerfield Township Hall. Notice of the public hearing shall be substantially in the form attached as Exhibit **C** and shall be provided by first class mail and by publication as required by Act 188 and other applicable laws.
