RESOLUTION NO. 2024 - 89

At a meeting of the Summerfield Township Board, Clare County, Michigan, held at 9971 N. Finley Lake Avenue, Harrison, MI 48625 on ______, 2024, at _____p.m.

The following preamble and Resolution was moved by ______ and seconded by ______

WHEREAS, townships may impose and levy *ad valorem* property taxes to finance lawful public improvements as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws. Specifically, townships may provide funds for providing fire protection; and

WHEREAS, the electors of Summerfield Township ("Township") previously authorized 0.750 mills to be levied for providing fire protection services to Summerfield Township, which has been reduced to 0.7099 mills by required millage rollbacks; and

WHEREAS, the previously-authorized fire millage has expired after last being levied in 2023, and thus will not be levied in 2024 in the absence of a renewal and increase; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board has determined that the original millage amount of 0.7500 mills will be insufficient to provide funds for providing fire protection services to Summerfield Township, and thus the Township Board wishes to increase this millage by 0.40 mills (increase of 0.4401 mills from current millage rate as reduced by millage rollbacks) to levy a total of 1.15 mills; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Summerfield Township (the "Township Board") wishes to renew and increase the fire millage for an additional four (4) years, 2024 through 2027 inclusive, at 1.15 mills.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Township Board of Summerfield Township, Clare County, Michigan, approves the following millage renewal question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the August 6, 2024, election ballot:

SUMMERFIELD TOWNSHIP FIRE MILLAGE RENEWAL AND INCREASE

Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Summerfield Township of 0.7500 mills (\$0.75 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to 0.7099 mills (\$0.71 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed to the originally approved millage amount, increased up to 1.15 mills (\$1.15 per \$1,000 of taxable value), and levied for four (4) years, 2024 through 2027 inclusive, for the purpose of providing fire protection to Summerfield Township, raising an estimated \$32,027.50 in 2024?

The Township Clerk shall facilitate with the County Clerk, as necessary and applicable, to ensure notices of registration and notices of election are posted and published, have ballots prepared and provided in sufficient quantity, and to do all things and provide all supplies necessary for the submission of this question at the election as required by law.

Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Summerfield Township of 0.7500 mills (\$0.75 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to 0.7099 mills (\$0.71 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed to the originally approved millage amount, increased up to 1.15 mills (\$1.15 per \$1,000 of taxable value), and levied for four (4) years, 2024 through 2027 inclusive, for the purpose of providing fire protection to Summerfield Township, raising an estimated \$32,027.50 in 2024?
