

SUMMERFIELD TOWNSHIP, CLARE COUNTY, MICHIGAN
RESOLUTION 2024-11 TO ADOPT
MICHIGAN GOLF CART LAW
Effective January 13, 2015

WHEREAS, "Golf Cart" refers to an unmodified vehicle designed for transportation on a golf course while playing the game of golf. Golf carts are not required to meet vehicle safety requirements of low-speed vehicles.

Therefore, a summary of the current Michigan law governing the use of Golf Carts on roads in Clare County and Summerfield Township.

- Operators must be at least 16 years of age and have a valid driver's license.
- Operators must adhere to all roads signaling requirements that apply to operation of a vehicle.
- Golf carts cannot exceed 15MPH.
- Golf carts may not be operated on a state trunk line highway. The operator may cross a state highway when operating on a street of a city, village or township, using the most direct line of crossing.
- Golf carts must travel on the right side of the roadway.
- Golf carts cannot be operated on a sidewalk.
- Golf carts may not be operated during the time period from ½ hour before sunset to ½ hour after sunrise.
- Operators are **not** required to wear a crash helmet.
- Operators are **not** required to have seat belts.
- Golf carts are **not** required to have an ORV sticker.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Summerfield Township Board adopts Resolution 2024-11 Golf Cart Law.
